3. Article Summary – Write a 3-5 sentence summary of what was discussed in the news article China's space program, CNSA, landed a space rover on the far side of the moon, which hasn't yet been charted or explored. The Chang'e-4 mission was a success as it landed on January 2<sup>nd</sup> with a number of scientific tools. The hope is that the next mission, the Chang'e-5, will collect the 4's samples and bring it back to earth. The hope is that this will help Chinese researchers with its ideas in creating a base on the moon and continue technological research relationships with other countries.

4. <u>Contextualization</u> – In 3-5 sentences, discuss the connection between what is discussed in the textbook and what is discussed in the article

During the early Ming Dynasty, the Chinese sent many naval expeditions into Southeast Asia but also towards India and East Africa. The move was both to establish diplomatic relationships, trade, and show the power of Ming China. Much like the Ming period, China continues to explore today, but instead of the sea, space is being explored. It also continues to establish diplomatic relationships through the sharing of space technologies with other countries. Unlike the Ming, though, the hope for the recent lunar landing is to establish a colony or at least a jumping off point and there seems to be a future in this exploration.

3. <u>Article Summary</u> – Write a 3-5 sentence summary of what was discussed in the news article In Mexico City, a sports game called Ulama is being revived from early Mesoamerican culture.

The game was historically significant because Mesoamerican cultures like the Aztecs used it to decide the winner and losers of war. The hope is that the new generation of Mexican peoples who learn to play will also learn about the traditions of their Mesoamerican ancestors.

4. <u>Contextualization</u> – In 3-5 sentences, discuss the connection between what is discussed in the textbook and what is discussed in the article

The Aztec civilization had an advanced culture prior to the arrival of the Europeans. As described in the textbook, even the Europeans who arrived at the Aztec empire saw their capital city as something to behold. A testament of the Mesoamerican culture's persistence even after they were conquered by the Spanish is shown through the willingness of the descendants of the native Americans to learn about their past culture, including reviving sports games like Ulama and the traditional languages.
