Directions: You and a partner will be making stimulus-based multiple-choice questions to reflect the historical analysis skills you have learned and to help you understand the complexity of these assessments

- 1. You and your partner will find and choose ONE historical source
 - a. Your group needs to find either a <u>primary</u> or <u>secondary</u> source from **Period 4-6**
 - b. Sources can be passages, pictures, charts, or maps
 - c. Sources must include **citation**
- 2. You must create two multiple-choice questions
 - a. Each multiple-choice question should reflect an analysis of the source
 - b. Each question needs to have **four** answer choices
 - There needs to be <u>an answer that is most correct</u>, another <u>second best</u> option but isn't correct based on information from the document, and <u>two</u> other responses that are reasonable, but incorrect
 - 1. **For each multiple-choice option**, you must write a proof of why the answer is correct or incorrect, explaining them further
 - ii. All options MUST BE REASONABLE
 - c. Questions and responses should be **original work** (not previous AP questions nor copied from elsewhere)
